This Sunday morning we will celebrate the triumphant entry into Jerusalem by Jesus, yet that celebration is dampened somewhat by the knowledge of the betrayal that awaited our Saviour. We will gather together to celebrate the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday to remember Jesus' final hours with His disciples, and yet we will be challenged by His command to all disciples (including us) to:

"Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. ³⁵By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

(John 13:34-35 NIV)

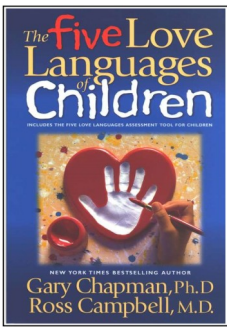
