Following the service, this enthusiastic group will begin the familiar 6-hour drive to Williamsburg, Kentucky. How can you help?

What is Mountain Outreach?

In the second poorest county in Kentucky, Mountain Outreach began as a concern among Cumberland College students for the poverty and desperation they saw so close about them. Initially focusing on home repairs and renovations during weekends and holidays, the ministry progressed to sponsor church mission work teams. Now under the direction of new Executive Director Marc Hensley, Mountain Outreach involves mission work teams from a number of states, working to build complete homes for needy families, giving them a warm, dry place to live.

University of the Cumberlands is proud of its liberal arts curriculum. Mountain Outreach is a wonderful outreach tool for this small but significant university.

Special Needs List...

Several items are especially needed. Can you help?

- **Building Materials** -- if they meet specifications -- are actively sought, and will offset our direct cash requirement dollar for dollar. If you have a lead on possible materials, please contact Roger Jones.
- **Volunteer Workers and Pickup Trucks** are needed to help pick up donated items, transport them to the church, and pack the truck(s). Pick up days are June 6 and 13, and 20. We will pack the truck on June 27, starting at about 8:00 AM. Please put this on your calendar. Refreshments (snacks, ice, and drinks) will also be welcomed to keep the hungry crew in good spirits! Can you help?
- **Tools** – our building ministry uses a tremendous number of tools and related blades, paintbrushes, rollers, nails, etc. We particularly need some sturdy stepladders to replace unstable old ones.
Do you have anything no longer needed?
- **Excess Household Goods**
We solicit your used household goods for our warehouse ministry. College Park expects to transport a truck load of donated goods and furnishings to Mountain Outreach, which will distribute it to needy families all over this impoverished area of Appalachia.
- **Scholarships** are needed to allow several very willing, able bodied volunteer workers to participate. A full scholarship of approximately \$200.00 pays the necessary lodging and food expense. Transportation can be readily arranged via carpooling.
